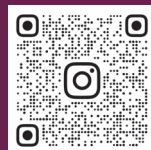

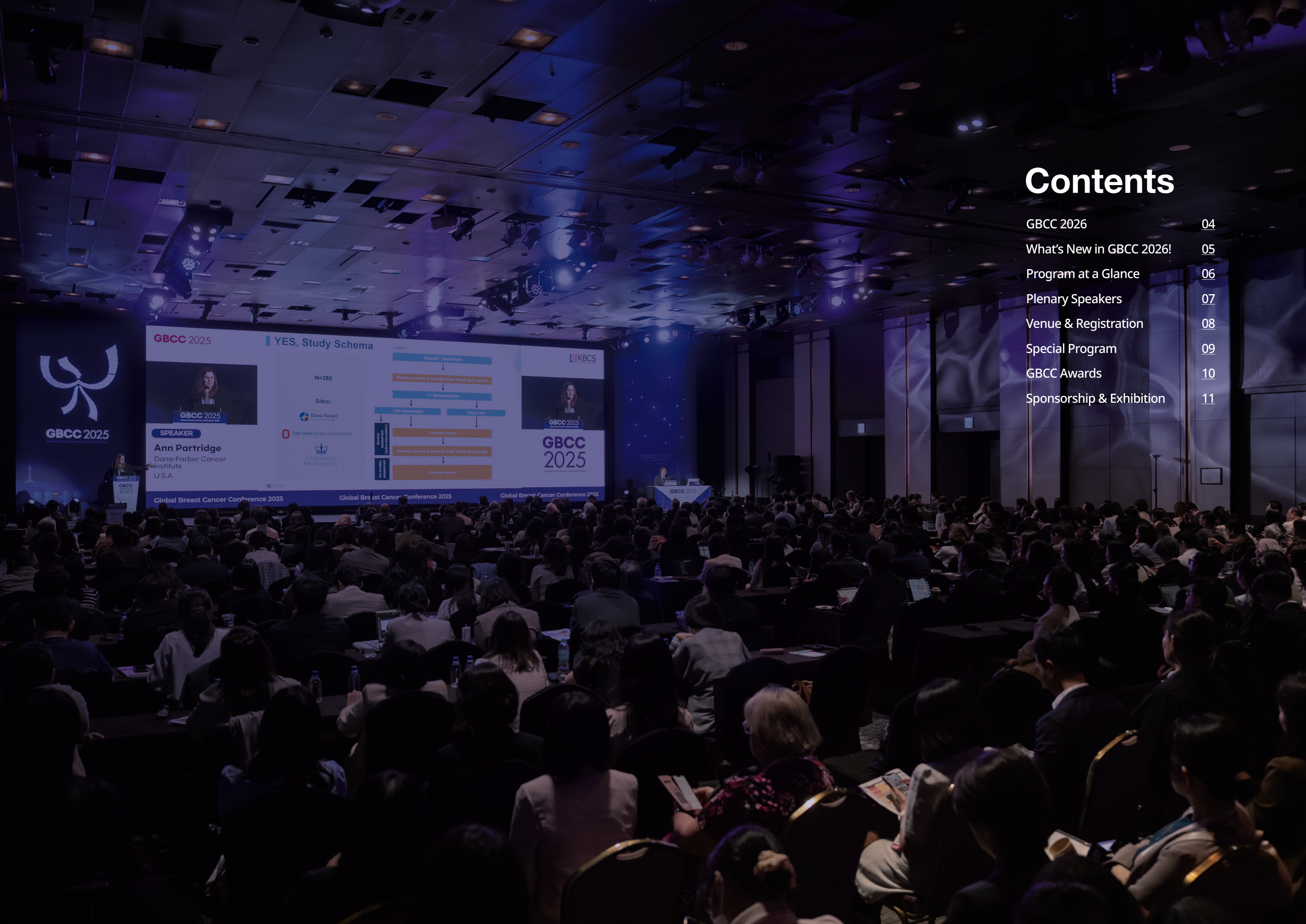

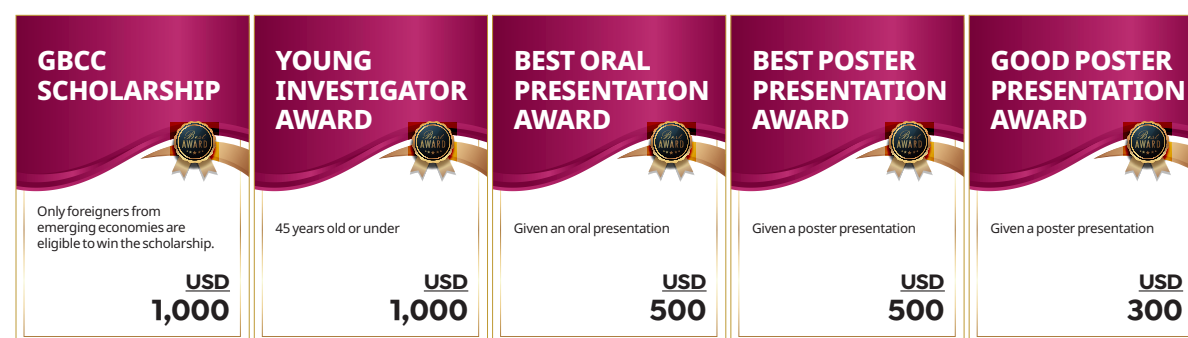
8 abstracts will be selected for on-site presentations, and the final awardees will be determined through live judging after the presentations.

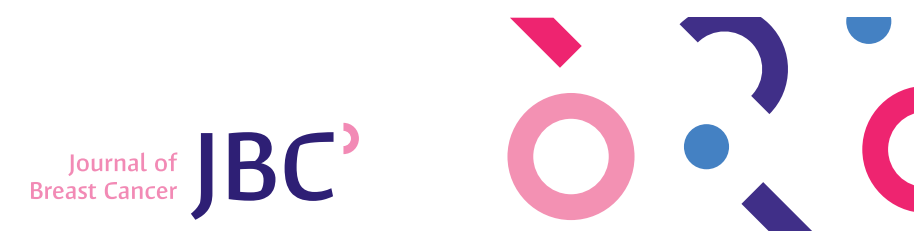

Journal of Breast Cancer (JBC) is one of the most influential journals issued by the Korean Breast Cancer Society (KBCS). It aims to provide a forum for the academic communication between medical doctors, basic science researchers, and health care professionals to be interested in breast cancer. To get this aim, we publish original investigations, review articles, brief communications including case reports, editorial opinions on the topics of importance to breast cancer, and welcome new research findings and epidemiological studies, especially when they contain a regional data to grab the international readers' interest. Although the journal is mainly dealing with the issues of breast cancer, rare cases among benign breast diseases or evidence-based scientifically written articles providing useful information for clinical practice can be published as well.
