



- Abstract acceptance will be notified around the middle of February, 2017 by email.
- The decision of the Scientific Committee on abstract acceptance is final. While authors' preferences for oral or poster presentations will be considered, the committee may offer an alternative format. No correspondence on their decision can be initiated by the authors.
