Bukchon Hanok Village

Surrounded by Gyeongbokgung Palace, Changdeokgung Palace and Jongmyo Shrine, Bukchon Hanok Village is home to hundreds of traditional houses, called hanok, that date back to the Joseon dynasty. The name Bukchon, which literally translates to "northern village," came about as the neighborhood lies north of two significant Seoul landmarks, Cheonggyecheon Stream and Jongno. Today, many of these hanoks operate as cultural centers, guesthouses, restaurants and tea houses, providing visitors with an opportunity to experience, learn and immerse themselves in traditional Korean culture.

The name seal or stamp is called a Dojang. A dojang is a stamp made from stone, wood, ivory or precious metals that displays the signature of the owner. Nowadays, you're most likely to only see ones made from rock. Experience the traditional culture of Korea by engraving your own stone stamp (seal engraving). Insadong, located in the heart of the city, is an important place where old but precious traditional goods are on display. There is one main road in Insadong with alleys on each side. Within these alleys are galleries, traditional restaurants, teahouses, and cafes.

The galleries are the heartbeat of Insadong. There are about 100 galleries in the area offering every example of traditional Korean fine art from paintings to sculptures. The most famous galleries are Hakgojae Gallery, which functions as the center of folk art, Gana Art Gallery, which promotes many promising artists, and Gana Art Center.

Mt. Bukhansan National Park

National parks are very rarely within a city, and yet Bukhansan Mountain in Seoul was designated as the 15th national park of Korea in 1983. The national park is like an ecological island because it's totally surrounded by urban areas. It's a popular natural park for over 20 million residents within the vicinity. There are also many historical and cultural sites including Bukhansanseong Fortress with over 2,000 years of history, over 100 Buddhist temples and monk's cells. This hiking route starts at Bamgol park ranger post. You will climb the Bagundae peak through the hidden wall ridge, then walk down the trail that leads you to Bukhansan mountain fortress wall and over at the Bukhansansung park ranger post.



Pajeon and Makgeolli

Pajeon is a savoury pancake made with scallions added to a rice flour batter and then fried in a pan. It can be eaten with just vegetables as the main ingredient, but popular varieties include kimchi jeon (with kimchi added to make it a little spicy) and haemulpajeon (with assorted seafood, like squid). Makgeolli is a rice alcohol, often called rice wine (even though it looks very different from Western style wine). It's thick and white in colour, often with some material from the rice left over. It is much sweeter than wine or other alcohol like beer, and . While makgeolli has a long history in Korea, these days is it available in many different flavours, including classic local ones like chestnut or yuja, and newer, more unique ones like cheese or peach. In Korea, there is a culture of eating makgeolli and pajeon after hiking to celebrate the end of the hike!

Prior Presidential House

The signature markings of the Presidential Residence of Cheong Wa Dae are its blue tiles on the Main Office; it is the first thing to catch one's attention upon viewing the premises. Approximately 150 thousand tiles compose the roof of the Main Office. Each tile was baked individually to make them strong enough to last for hundreds of years.

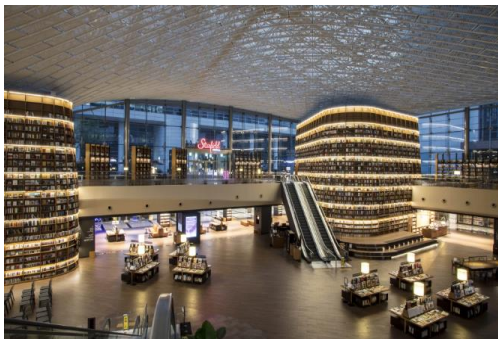

While the consumption of the two has been around for decades, the term's popularity soared during the 2010 World Cup when fans would enjoy chimaek as they watched games.

Suwon Fortress (World Heritage)

Suwon was one of four main regional government centers during the Joseon dynasty. Hwaseong Fortress, built to protect the city, was designated as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site on December 12, 1997 for its historical value. The fortress offers various performances daily as well as the Suwon Hwaseong Cultural Festival every fall. The walls stretch for 5,700 kilometers, with Paldalsan Mountain at the center. The fortress, constructed from 1794 to 1796, was built as a display of King Jeongjo's filial piety towards his father and to build a new pioneer city with its own economic power.



Korean Folk Village

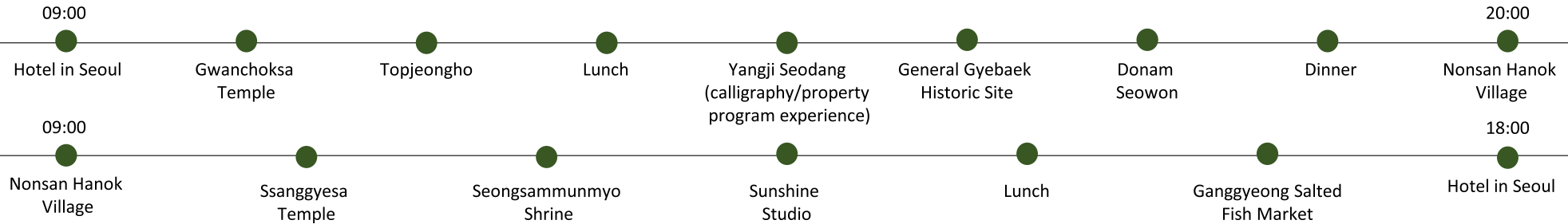
Korean Folk Village introduces traditional culture from the late Joseon period to both local and international visitors through cultural classes experience, shaman faith, seasonal customs and others. It recreated the past through the restoration of houses from the Joseon dynasty. Performances including nongak (farmer's music), martial arts on horseback, traditional wedding ceremony, and other special events are available by season. In particular, "Welcome to Joseon," an event held every May, takes visitors back to the past. In addition, a family-friendly theme park equipped with 15 exciting attractions is also available. Visitors can also try various Korean foods at the market street.

Gwanchoksa Temple

Gwanchoksa Temple in Nonsan, Chungcheongnam-do is located at the foot of Banyasan Mountain (100 meters in elevation). This temple enshrines a Seokjomireukbosalipsang Buddha (Treasure), which was built over the course of 38 years, beginning in 967 during the Goryeo period.



Yangji Seodang

Yangji Seodang is a traditional Seodang located in Songjeong-ri, Yeosan-myeon, Nonsan-si, Chungcheongnam-do. Seodang were private village schools providing elementary education during the Goryeo and Joseon dynasties of Korea. You can experience Chinese character education, calligraphy, and etiquette.



Nonsan Hanok Village

Nonsan Hanok Village was created in harmony with the beauty of traditional hanok and modern practicality. You can experience healing of the mind through our unique residential culture experience, and various traditional cultural experiences await you.



Ssanggyesa Temple

Ssanggyesa Temple was founded on the southern foothills of Jirisan Mountain in 722 during the reign of Silla King Seongdeok. The temple is famous for the 6-kilometer stretch of cherry blossom trees that bloom each spring. The temple was originally called Okcheonsa Temple, but was changed to the current Ssanggyesa Temple in 887.



Sunshine Studio

A set built for the production of the TV drama MR. SUNSHINE, it recreates the old Seoul of 1900s (from the end of Chosun Dynasty to the Korean Empire, before the colonization of Japan). The set contains various types of traditional houses, such as the traditional tiled houses of aristocrats and the thatched houses of commoners, as well as modernized buildings, old Seoul's trams, Hansung Electric Power Company, and a tailor shop.

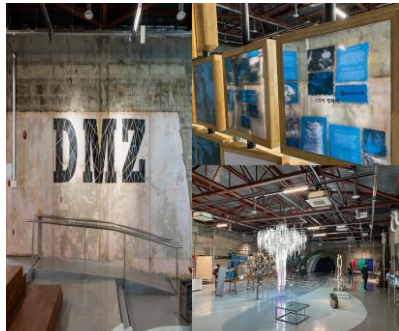

Imjingak Park

You can look at meaningful facilities related to the Korean War, such as the Freedom Bridge restored to exchange prisoners during the Korean War, the Gyeongui Line steam locomotive that was shot by 1,020 bullets and left in the DMZ, and the Unification Pond modeled after the Korean Peninsula.



Camp Greaves

Camp Greaves served as a camp base for the 506th US 2nd Infantry Division for about 50 years after the ceasefire agreement of the Korean War. The camp has been turned into a peace and security experience facility for local artists and it is located approximately 2 km away from the DMZ.



The 3rd Infiltration Tunnel

The highlight of the DMZ tour is to explore a tunnel dug by North Korea. Since 1974, South Army has discovered four tunnels crossing the MDL. The tunnels are believed to have been planned as a military invasion or infiltration route.



Dora Observatory

Dora Observatory, or OP Dora is the closest observation post to North Korea. From the observation platform, North Korean scenery is visible, and so are the outskirts of Gaeseong City, the 3rd largest city of North Korea.



Gondola

It is the first gondola that connects the private area and the civilian access control area, and it runs 1.7km back and forth between Imjingak, (the southern platform), and the northern platform, across the Imjin River. After boarding the gondola, visit Camp Greaves and the Peace Observatory.
